INTRODUCTION

Association Social Economy Slovenia (hereinafter referred to as ASES) is an umbrella organization of social economy in Slovenia. ASES is an independent, non-governmental, non-political institution. It represents its members who actively work in the field of social economy, regardless of their organizational form. The members of ASES are non-governmental organizations, cooperatives, social enterprises, emerging social enterprises, institutions of supportive environment, humanitarian organizations and individuals who want to contribute to the development of social entrepreneurship. Its main function is to provide services for its member organizations and other actors in social economy, by coordinating dialogue of the sector towards the state, the government and other public and private actors, functions as supportive environment in the fields of education, networking, legal support, and other fields perceived as important for the members and engages in international cooperation of the sector.

The report contains:

- an overview of the activities in 2018, which include: organization of conferences, participation of our members in other conferences at home and abroad, carrying out study cases and guided visits by social enterprises, participation in trade fairs with promotional stands and member meetings (regular monthly meetings, interim meetings of the management and supervisory boards, branch openings, assembly, picnic);
- overview of projects, which cover: Buy Responsible campaign, cooperation with the University of Maribor, the establishment of the Yunus business center and calls for applications to the ASES;
- activity plan 2019.

SUMMARY

In 2018, Slovenia presided over the Supervisory Committee of the Luxembourg Declaration to the group of European countries in the field of social economy. As a result, Maribor was selected as the European capital of social economy.

Under the leadership of the Chairman of the Supervisory Board of the Secretary of State in the Prime Minister's Office Tadej Slapnik, a technical secretariat was established for the implementation of the presidency and the coordination group for the implementation of the Maribor, European Capital of Social Economy project.

A large part of the implementation of the activities of the capital was carried out by the ASES Podravje branch team of Miro Mihec, Mirjana Ivanuša, and Iris Magajna.

Despite the belated proclamation of the capital, the municipality of Maribor cooperated well with the association, primarily by providing the infrastructure (event facilities) and personal engagement of deputy mayor Saša Pelko. However, even with the day of open doors in the field of social economy, the association did not receive state financial support. Therefore,

members of the Management and Supervisory Board of ASES carried out all activities by voluntary work.

The goals we set for 2018:

- identification of social economy actors and their integration, especially in Osrednja Slovenija and Podravje region;
- within the framework of the Buy Responsible campaign: setting up an e-catalogue of social, socially responsible and ethical enterprises with the aim of business linking between the enterprises (campaign goal from December 2017 to December 2018 inclusion of 200 responsible companies, clear labelling and social impact, catalog of products and services, 100,000 new orders);
- promotion of social economy at home and abroad;
- cooperating with the University of Maribor in further developing social entrepreneurship.

The goals we managed to achieve in 2018:

- identification of social economy actors and their integration through the organization of conferences, regular monthly meetings of the ASES Podravje, trade fair activities and case studies, where a group of 20 active entrepreneurs was formed;
- within the framework of the Buy Responsible campaign: inclusion of 120 responsible companies in an e-catalogue of products and services (<u>link</u>) and the procurement of 100,000 new orders;
- establishing a cooperation with the University of Maribor for the creation of the Yunus business center (meeting with the new rector, former vice-rector, deputy secretary general and the development department, presentation of social economy and its capital at two international events of the University);
- in the field of promotion: more than 30 presentations at conferences, regular announcements on Facebook (<u>link</u>) and on the website (<u>link</u>) on an almost daily basis, e-news every 10 days, over 30 media announcements;
- setting up the ASES services (link);
- opening additional branches (link);
- setting up mentor services (link);
- within the framework of the With Creative Inclusion to Decent Work for Precarious Workers tender:
 - begin establishing the Odgovorni ustvarjalci, z.b.p., so.p. cooperation (as founders), including 15 cooperative members;
 - creating the Create Responsible platform (as owners; <u>link</u>) and the Facebook community (<u>link</u>) dedicated to hiring and delivering talent from the precarious workforce;
 - conducting 12 workshops, 3 academies and a final conference for the creative involvement of precarious workers (<u>link</u>).
- preparing a recommendation for the operation of the future European Capitals of Social Economy and handing them over at the closing conference on 3rd December 2018 to the representatives of the next capital of Strasbourg.

COOPERATION WITH THE UNIVERSITY AND ESTABLISHING THE YUNUS CENTER

In 2012, letters of intent for the establishment of a Yunus center at the University of Maribor were exchanged between the then rector Daniel Rebolj and the then Secretary General of the Forum for Social Entrepreneurship Tadej Slapnik and Muhammed Yunus. Talks on the establishment of the Yunus center continued in 2018. We organized two meetings (Miro Mihec, Iris Magajna, and Mirjana Ivanuša) with the vice-rector Lučka Lorber, Deputy Secretary-General Mladen Kraljič and representatives of the development department. We contacted the new rector of the University of Maribor and invited him to the Green Transformation and Circular Economy conference and to the 4th When I Raise myself, I Raise Maribor festival on 21st June 2018 in Maribor. We also organized two presentations on social economy and the Capital at the University of Maribor. The university is ready to cooperate by coapplying to a suitable tender, which will allow for the establishment of the Yunus center.

MARIBOR, EUROPEAN CAPITAL OF SOCIAL ECONOMY AND TECHNICAL SECRETARIAT OF SLOVENIA'S PRESIDENCY TO THE SUPERVISORY BOARD OF LUXEMBOURG DECLARATION

In 2018, Slovenia presided over the Supervisory Board of the Luxembourg Declaration to the group of European countries in the field of social economy at the initiative of the then Chairman of the Supervisory Board of the Secretary of State in the Prime Minister's Office for Social, Green and Circular Economy Tadej Slapnik. As a result, Maribor was chosen as the European capital of social economy. The selection took place so quickly, that the state and

the municipality did not have time to respond with a national campaign and a suitable financial budget. Therefore, we held the presidency and the Capital within the framework of ASES, the technical secretariat and working as volunteers at the coordination committee within our capabilities in terms of time, personnel and finances. However, we received logistical support and some reimbursed costs, especially from the Municipality of Maribor.

During the closing conference of the 9th Days of Social Economy on 3rd December 2018 in Maribor, we presented the results of the Maribor, European Capital of Social Economy project and handed over the next capital to the representative of the French city of Strasbourg Sarah Robin at a ceremonial event at the The Old Vine House.

Results

As volunteers, we emphasized the integration of social enterprises by offering free promotion stalls at fairs, guided study tours of good practices, regular monthly meetings and mapping social entrepreneurs.

During the year, we:

- organized more than 50 events in Slovenia;
- organized 10 events abroad;
- included more than 450 individuals;
- came in contact with more than 350 enterprises.

WITH CREATIVE INCLUSION TO DECENT WORK FOR PRECARIOUS WORKERS

During the closing conference of the 9th Days of Social Economy on 3rd December 2018 in Maribor, we presented the results of the With Creative Inclusion to Decent Work MGRT ESS project, dealing with solutions for precarious workers by using blockchain technologies.

With the implementation of 12 workshops for precarious workers, ECTA Day, two-day conferences and launch of the www.create-responsible.eu e-platform, we completed the project, and, at the same time, started to create the Responsible creators z.b.o. so.p. cooperative. ASES thus became the owner of the Create Responsible e-platform. The activities of ASES in 2018 were intertwined with the activities of the With Creative Inclusion for Decent Work project (a report can be viewed here), as well as with those of the Maribor, European Capital of Social Economy 2018 project.

ACTIVITY PLANING – GOALS for 2019

- As an umbrella organization of social economy in Slovenia, we need a government interlocutor
- Reserved public procurement for social enterprises and enterprises with a positive social impact
- Public works for social enterprises (public works might be abolished in 2020)
- Promoting and raising public awareness of the importance of social economy for society, especially for vulnerable groups (the experience of the capital is that the general public was not aware of the presidency, only the stakeholders that were directly or indirectly involved in the activities)
- Implement the possibility of volunteering in social enterprises now only possible in some municipalities; that way, the creators of the cooperative could enter the business of natural persons
- System solution for precarious workers and integration of natural persons into a business through a cooperative
- Participation in projects, also by including ASES members (not all projects need to be implemented by the Management Board)
- Participation in the national social economy council
- Participation in the National Council
- Cooperation with similar organizations also at a national level
- Interdepartmental cooperation (social economy connects with different ministries, from social through the economy to the environment) and cross-sectoral cooperation (creative industries, sharing economy, blockchain, etc.)

- Setting up a standalone Buy Responsible website/platform or exposure within the existing Create-responsible.eu e-platform
