# What is the Conference about ?

- 2 days event on **26 and 27 November 2020**;
- Jointly organized by the **European Commission** and the **City of Mannheim**;
- **Objectives:** to strengthen the social economy in Europe and harness its contribution to economic development, social inclusion, as well as, green and digital transition.



# What is the Conference about ?

- **Bring together** public and private stakeholders, civil representatives and scholars;
- **Reinforce** networks, increase the visibility of social economy, exchange best practices and success stories;
- **Demonstrate** how social economy and social enterprises can be an instrument to implement the political priorities of the new Commission.



# Preparation of the Conference

- Conference is **co-designed** with stakeholders;
- **Participatory and interactive Summit**;
- Sessions will focus on **three dimensions**: digitalisation, (social) innovation, cross-country and cross sectoral collaboration.



# How will proposals be selected ?



Proposals to be selected in **two phases**:

**1. Pre-selection phase:** general outline of the session;

**2. Confirmation phase:** full proposals.

# What support is offered to selected session organisers ?

- The **EUSES team** will support the stakeholder sessions by offering the responsible organisers:
- **45 minutes**, (e.g. Panel), **90 minutes** (e.g. Input Session) or exceptionally **180 minutes long** slots as part of the official summit programme;
- **Promotion of the session** through the event's promotion channels, logo of your organization on the official EUSES Website, etc.

# What is the timetable to apply ?

- For Phase 1:

Submit your proposal by **27 March 2020**.

The EUSES team will inform applicants of the results of the pre-selection phase by **8 May 2020**.

- For Phase 2:

Full proposal to be received **by 8 June**.

The organisers will inform applicants of the results by **1 July 2020**.

# Apart from the workshops – How can stakeholders contribute ?

- **Call to select organisations + enterprises** that will have a stand during the fair (Spring 2020);
- **Site visits** are planned for the second day of the Conference;
- A **social innovation night** will take place after the Summit + **Satellite events** will happen in the city in cooperation with Commission services.
